## **Reclamation to Host Public Meeting on Horsetooth Construction Work**

*Ft. Collins:* The U.S. Bureau of Reclamation will host a public meeting on April 25<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m. in room C-146 of the Clark building at Colorado State University. The purpose of the meeting is to present information and collect public input concerning the second phase of construction work of the Horsetooth Dams' Modification Project.

Phase 2 of the modification project will be the installation of a filter and berm at the reservoir's three east-facing dams: Solider Canyon, Dixon Canyon, and Spring Canyon. The meeting agenda will include:

1. Update on progress of first contract at Horsetooth Dam
2. Scope of work planned for Phase 2
3. Impacts to Recreation
4. Road closures and delays
5. Hauling

After information about the new contract is presented, the meeting will open for public comment. Comments from the public will be incorporated, as needed, into the contract for Phase 2.
